## Be a Ladybug Girl with Lulu! Diagram 1

## Instructions:

- 1. Photocopy or trace the outline of the wings onto thick, 11 x 17 paper. Make 2 wings (or 4 for double-sided wings) per child.
- 2. Cut out the wings and punch holes where shown. Line up the tips of the wings so that hole number 1 is overlapping. Using a small piece of string, tie the two wings together through hole 1. Cut and measure 2 one-foot lengths of string. Thread one string through hole 2 from back to front and through hole 3 from front to back and tie ends in a bow, making a strap. Repeat on other wing. Slip child's arms through loops and tighten string as necessary. (See Diagram 1)
- 3. Provide each child with crayons or markers (be sure to have plenty of red and black!) so they can decorate their wings.
- 4. Using 4 pipe-cleaners, help each child create antennae to go with their wings. Make a circle with two pipe-cleaners attached to each other on either end. Then, connect one standing straight up on either side of the circle. Curl the top of each vertical pipe-cleaner. (See Diagram 2)
